We hereinafter firmly disapprove the extremist manifestations

We, members of the group of initiative of protesting against the opening of the office of the European Parliament Member, Szegedi Csanád, from the Movement for a Better Hungary (Jobbik Magyarorszagert), in Tîrgu Mureş (or in other places in Transylvania), can state after the first week following our protest, that many citizens of Tîrgu Mureş, or other places of Transylvania, Romania, together with persons from other corners of the world, of different nationalities and political convictions, have shown their solidarity with this civil initiative of protest (during these 5 days, the protest was signed by more than one thousand persons) - thus firmly rejecting any politics based on race and consanguinity (on "blood relations"), as well as the policy of contesting the actual European status quo. The signatories of the protest reject, at the same time, all types of political approach, based on the contestation of the political representatives chosen in a democratic way, and all types of political actions which ignore the principles of parliamentary democracy.

The fact that the signatories actively refuse these tendencies is pleasing, along with the fact that they also refuse the trials to make such tendencies proliferate in our region, leading to nationa, intra-ethnic and interethnic tensions. The initiators of the protest take note of one thousand signatures as being the expression and the proof of the fact that the inhabitants of Transylvania are committed to the tradition of tolerance and peaceful coexistence of different nations. The gathering of signatures will stop, but the idea of the presence of the above mentioned office – as well as the type of politics promoted by the Movement Jobbik – is and shall be rejected also in the future. We ask the signatories of the protest and the responsible citizens, irrespective of the ethnic community they belong to, to keep monitoring the activity in Transylvania of this office and of the Movement Jobbik Magyarorszagert (For a Better Hungary), and to inform their fellow-citizens and the public opinion about any kind of extremist manifestation. It is our obligation to unmask all extremist tendencies, no matter where they come from, for it is more than our heart's ease at stake.
